- Listen to Swing High, Swing Low
- Reinforce opposites
- Read *Fix It Up* and *Will Ron Fix His Rig?*
- Practice building words by adding correct letters
- Distinguish between reality and fantasy
- Write sentences using the new sight words *up* and *down*
- Practice subtracting with manipulatives
- Reinforce measuring with height and length
- Listen to The Most Perfect Spot, The Little House, The Stray Dog and City Sounds
- Respond to literature by illustrating the characters perfect spot
- Identify their perfect spot
