**Missionary Appeal**

**June 15 & 16**

***Redemptorist Vice-Province of Fortaleza, Brazil***



On the weekend of Saturday, June 15 and Sunday, June 16, our parish will be visited by a missionary from Brazil, as part of the Missionary Cooperative Program of the San Francisco Archdiocese. Fr. Peter McCarthy, C.Ss.R. will speak at all our Masses about the Mission of the Redemptorist Vice-Province of Fortaleza, Brazil. This mission is located in the North-East of Brazil in the States of Ceará, Piauí and Maranhão. Originally begun as an overseas mission of the Redemptorist Province of Dublin, Ireland, the Fortaleza Vice-Province is now being administered by native Brazilian Redemptorists who have become part of the group over the years. Their work is to spread the Good News of the love of God for all, especially for the poor, abandoned and excluded in this region which is the most impoverished region of Brazil. The missionaries work with the poorest of the poor in favelas (shanty-towns), hospitals and prisons. The parishes and pastoral areas administered by the Redemptorist missionaries serve both urban and rural communities, reaching out to street children, AIDS and cancer patients and young people at risk.

A special collection will be taken up at all the Masses and the proceeds will go toward helping the Redemptorist Mission in Fortaleza, Brazil.

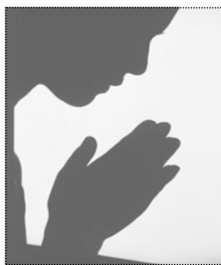

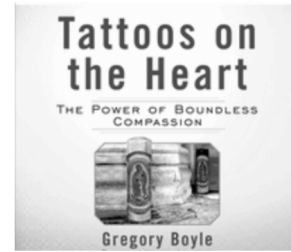

## *Welcome Santino!*

Dear Friends,

This weekend we welcome to our parish Santino Ambrosini, a seminarian studying for the priesthood for service in our archdiocese. The Archbishop has assigned Santino to Saint Patrick for the summer months of June and July after which he will return to seminary for further studies.

Santino was born and raised in Marin County. He attended elementary school at St. Rita, Fairfax and high school at Marin Catholic. Discerning the priesthood, he entered the seminary after high school and was sent to Mount Angel Seminary in St. Benedict, Oregon. After two years there, he transferred to Theological College at the Catholic University of America, in Washington, D.C. for the Basselin Scholars Program, a three-year course of study for seminarians where students earn a Bachelor's degree and Licentiate in Philosophy. Santino will be entering his third year of the Basselin Program this upcoming academic year. While with us this summer, he will be writing his thesis entitled "The Metaphysics of Gender in St. Thomas Aquinas."

I am sure you will enjoy meeting and getting to know Santino whom we warmly welcome into our faith community.
