## Schedule

The schedule usually runs from near the start of the school year through the Easter Season, but this can vary depending on your situation. There are weekly sessions on Wednesdays, 6:15-7:30pm. These coordinate with the BISD holidays. These cover different topics and bible studies. Attendance is required to receive the sacraments.

## Lent

Our formation shifts from understanding Catholic teaching to an emphasis on bible study and added prayer as we undergo several church rites that will lead to the Easter sacraments.
