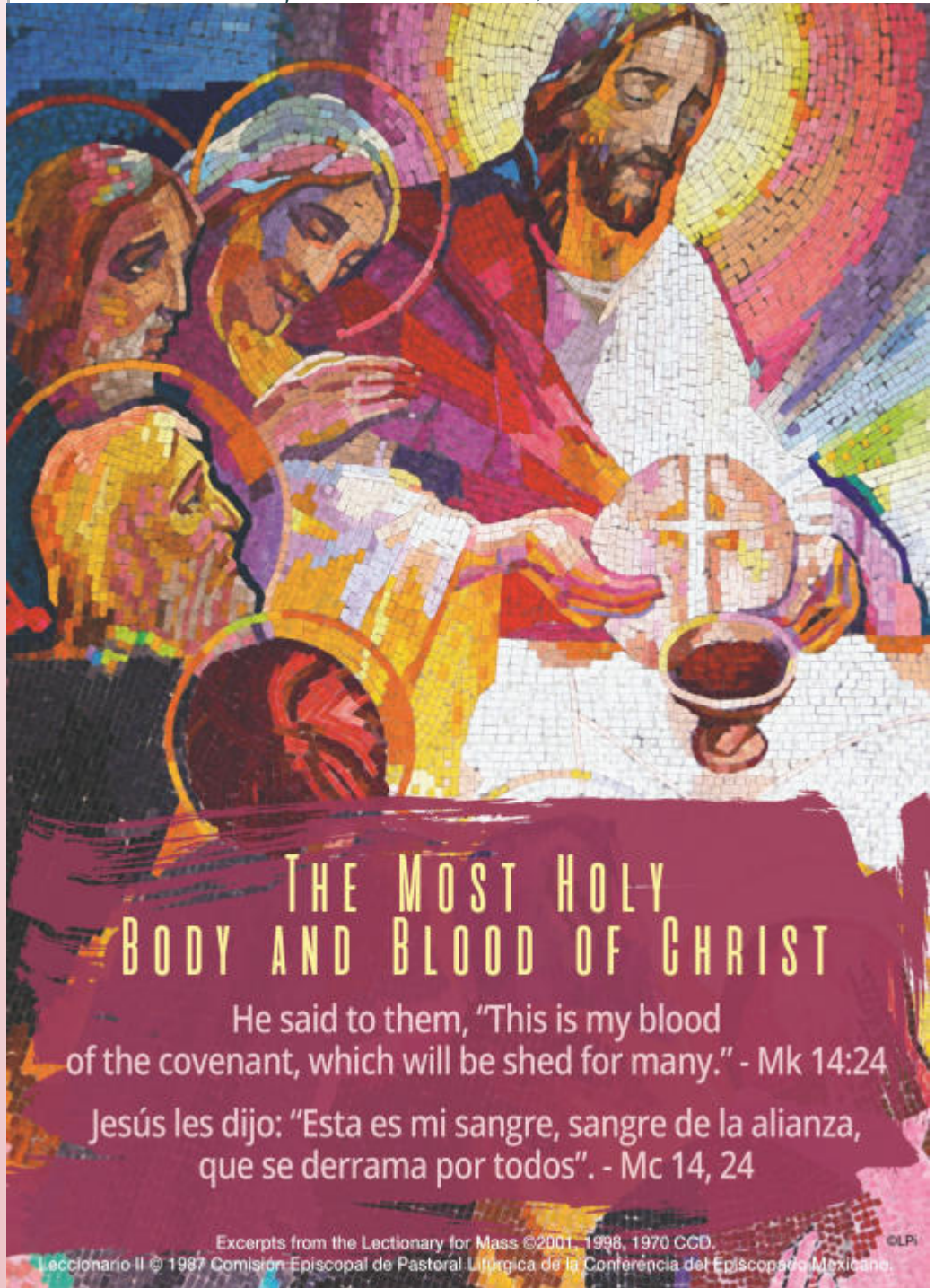

Sunday Obligation Returns

Beginning next weekend, all Catholics in Indiana are once again obligated to attend Mass on Sunday (or the Vigil Mass on Saturday evening). The bishops' dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass, because of Covid, will no longer exist. There are exceptions, as always, for those who are seriously ill or have symptoms of Covid, for those who cannot attend Mass because of infirmity, medical restrictions, or lack of transportation, and for those who are caring for and cannot leave a seriously ill person. Please advise your friends and families of the returning obligation to attend Mass every Sunday.

Along with the obligation to attend Mass, our Bishop is lifting most of the restrictions put in place because of the Covid pandemic. Masks in our pastorate will no longer be strictly required. However, following CDC guidelines, those who are not fully vaccinated, are asked to wear a mask. The tape/rope between pews will be removed. Holy water will return to the fonts. Hymnals and missalettes will return to the pews. The sign of peace will return, however without physical contact (e.g. no handshaking, but rather a bow of the head, or a wave to others).

Communion with the Precious Blood is still not permitted. Hand sanitizer and masks will still be provided.

DRE/Youth Minister Position

Our Lady of the Lakes Parish in Monticello, IN is currently searching for a Director of Religious Education and Youth Ministry. The position will be part-time, approximately 15-20 hours per week. GOSPEL MEDITATION

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

As our world faces so much turmoil and change, it is now more important than ever to remember who God is, who we are and where we are going. It is easy to get distract-



ed and lose focus, especially when we are being pulled in so many directions. We can not only lose sight of God but one another. True happiness, for the young and old alike, becomes an obtainable goal.

St. John Maria Vianney says it so well. "There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, he would have given it to us." Only the Eucharist has the ability to connect, sustain, strengthen, and properly orient us, not only on the road of this life but the road of life eternal. Knowing this, when life gets challenging, unsettling, and difficult, we can rely on and cling to this gift we have in the Real Presence of Christ. This actual encounter with God celebrates God's unconditional love for us and grounds us to the truth of who we are in a way nothing else is able to do. Because through the Eucharist we really do become the Body of Christ, we are also bonded together in a most perfect way to one another as the Body.
