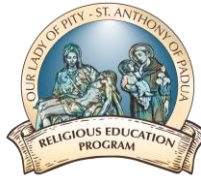

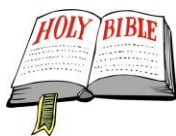

## NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**“Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen... for those who speak thus show that they are seeking a homeland.” “Do not be afraid any longer, little flock, for your Father is pleased to give you the Kingdom.”**

Remember the flamboyant congressman and minister known for his mantra ‘Keep the faith baby’? It is faith in God, belief in His word which gives meaning to life. I ask myself what I hope for and what is the evidence not seen.
