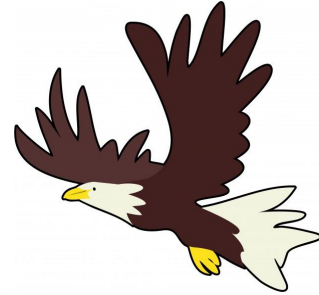


2nd GRADE
