Whoo Hoo! The second grade filled the marble jar again this week. I will be giving them a treat by next week. Good job working hard 2nd graders!

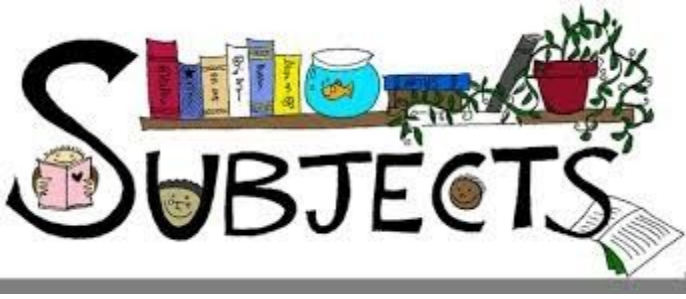
