WEEK OF FEBRUARY 3RD

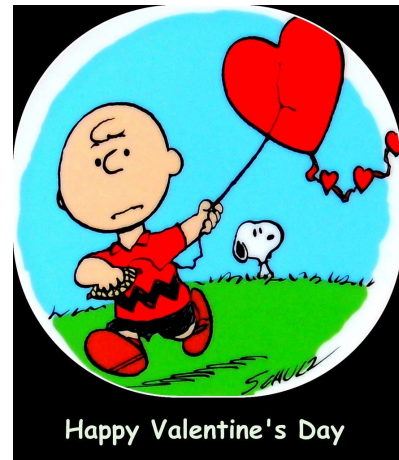
