Course Specifics:

Art Class Expectations:

- Students often are allowed to talk to their peers while working.
- However, other classroom rules are STRICTLY enforced.
- Failure to disregard classroom rules will result in appropriate consequence.

Students are expected to:

- ASK for permission before talking, or leaving the classroom.
- Be PATIENT and COOPERATIVE in class at all times!
- Follow transition rules every time without exception.
- Students MUST use headphones if listening to appropriate music in class, while working. (Middle School ONLY)
