Special thanks to everyone who makes-up their envelopes for weekends missed due to vacations, illness or weather. Our weekly bills average \$3,000 year round (not including oil).

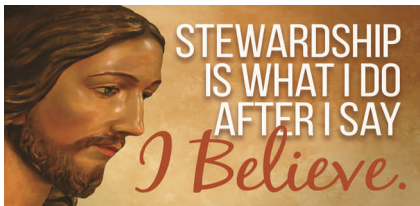
Last weekend's collections will be printed in next weekend's bulletin due to an early deadline.
