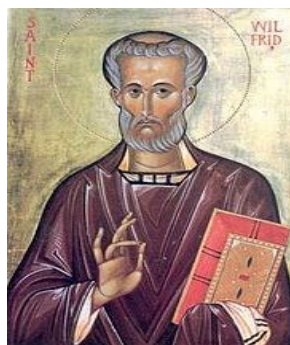
-Second Reading
