Our 4th annual Teens, Trucks, & Traffic event will be held at **Richland College / Progress City**, located at One College Park, in Decatur, Illinois.

"Teens, Trucks, & Traffic", a division of the **Illinois Trucking Foundation**, is a program that further educates teen drivers on traffic safety. The program not only reinforces what teens already learn in driver's education class, but also educates teens about the NO-Zone areas around a commercial motor vehicle and brings about a hands-on experience regarding traffic safety that students will never forget!

McLeod Express and **ADM Trucking** will be hosting this year's **NO-Zone** training, where students will have the opportunity to sit in a car and a commercial motor vehicle and recognize the blind areas (NO-Zone) around them, first hand.

The **Illinois State Police** will teach about what is known as the **Fatal Four** - texting and driving, drinking and driving, speeding, and failure to wear a seatbelt. The Crash Car, Seatbelt Simulator, and Golf Carts with impairment goggles are tools used to raise awareness during this training session.

The **Street Smart** presentation takes the audience into the real-life drama experienced by the firefighter/paramedics as they work to save the lives of individuals who have made poor choices when it comes to distracted driving, drinking or using drugs, impaired driving or getting in the vehicle with an impaired driver and the non-compliance of seat belts.

Students who attend the event will receive a T-shirt and a NO Zone bracelet, along with a commitment card and other safety materials. Lunch is also provided.

In April 2018, 16 area schools and 734 students attended this event at RCC-Progress City. This year we have invited 18 schools and are hoping to reach our goal of 1000 students. Each school attends one of the 3 days on the schedule and classes run from 9am-2pm daily.

IN CONSIDERATION for allowing the minor (Student) to participate in any way in the event or activity encompassed by this Agreement, the parent and/or guardian and the minor do hereby fully and knowingly assume all risks associated with participation in the Seminar, event or activity and further agree to forever release, waive, defend and indemnify the Illinois Trucking Foundation, its professional driving and volunteer instructors, and all of the program sponsors, and all of the officers, directors, employees, agents, parent companies, affiliates, successors and assigns of each of the aforementioned, from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, costs, actions, judgments, expenses and liabilities of every kind and nature whatsoever, including, but not limited to, any claim or demand as a result of injury to the Student or from the death of the student while the Student is participating in the seminar or engaging in any activities related to the vehicles or the seminar while on the property and premises of Richland Community College/Progress City.
