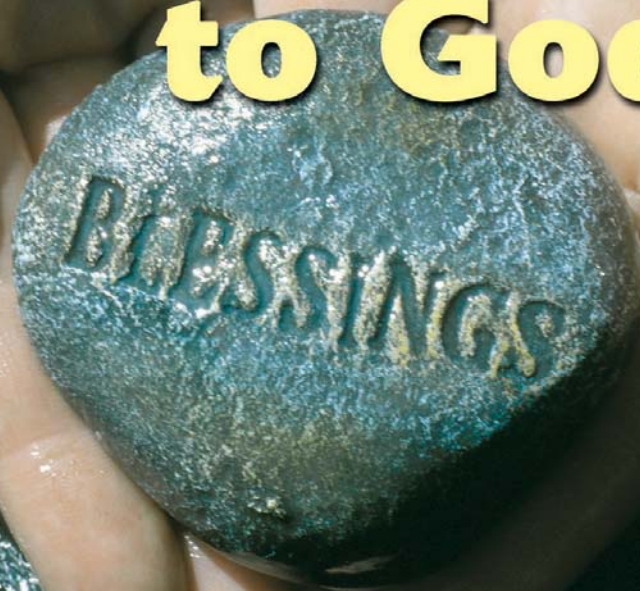

Mary's Strength

When we see a child that is gifted we tend to follow that child as she or he grows. We want to encourage and participate in the child's life and take delight in the young person's accomplishments. We feel fortunate when we become a part of the person's development into full adulthood.

From early on we watch the parents. How much did they contribute to the child's blossoming into a "chosen" person? Did the child get strength from the parents? Did the parents and the son or daughter get help from outside sources? How can more people get to know and learn from the person? As Christians we know that what the secular world calls "gifted" we call "blest". God chooses to bless some people with special graces.

This is the story of Mary, Joseph and their son, Jesus. Mary had extraordinary strength as she participated in her son's life from infancy through His death on the cross. Mary was able to live her life and be there for Jesus with the support of special graces from God the Father and from His Holy Spirit.

Many see Mary and Jesus as victims. Without denying that, we as Catholics, believe that Mary and her Son, the Son of God, allowed their life experiences to occur in order to fulfill the Father's plan for the redemption of all persons. Mary was as close to her Son during His Passion and death on the cross as humanly and spiritually possible. Mary was with her Son, not as a helpless victim-parent, but as a co-participant in her Son's work to save all people in our Father's creation.

Mary, we pray to you that we may join our lives to the redemptive work of you and your Son Our Lord Jesus Christ. Don't look at our weaknesses but at each of our efforts to draw closer to the Holy Family. Joseph, we ask you to support us. You taught your Son skills He would use throughout His life to save us from ourselves. May Jesus, Mary and Joseph be in our mind, on our lips and in our heart as we draw joy from their lives.
