From Father's Desk

My Dear Parish,

This is one of those weekends where things just come together. We'll be celebrating three events: 1) Trinity Sunday; 2) the Ordination of ten new priests; and 3) Father's Day. At first these three may seem not to go together. But a closer look shows they really do.

“The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the "hierarchy of the truths of faith". The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin".” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 234)

We've just spent the last six months contemplating how the Trinity has been revealed to us through Christ. We'll spend the next six months going to all the nations and telling them what we've seen and heard.

We can be inspired by the examples of the Ten newly ordained priests. God continues to give us shepherds after his heart. It is the will of the Three Persons of the Blessed Trinity that we have the means for salvation.

Every father knows the desire to provide well for his family. The coincidence of Trinity Sunday and the Ordination of the Ten new priests should be a strong encouragement for all Fathers to reflect the love of God and to lay down their lives for the salvation of their children. In doing so, with the courage that comes from the Holy Spirit, they will be imitating the example of Christ, the only-begotten of the Father.

May our parish grow stronger by our prayerful consideration of the Mystery of the Holy Trinity.
