Soon, we will celebrate two feasts. The Ascension will close Jesus' earthly life as he is raised to the Father, while the feast of Pentecost will draw our attention to the descending Holy Spirit who comes to fulfill Jesus' promise to us: "I will not leave you orphaned...I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, to be with you forever. This is the Spirit of truth."

These final movements in the Easter season prepare us to accept the great commission we hear in John's Gospel to go forth in this life to love and to serve the Lord.
