## **Saint Blaise and Blessing of the Throats**

On February 3, we commemorate St. Blaise, a physician and a Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia who was tortured and martyred for his faith in the year 316. His devotion spread throughout the entire Church in the Middle Ages because he was widely known to have miraculously cured a little boy who nearly died because of a fishbone in his throat. From the 8<sup>th</sup> century he has been invoked on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illnesses of the throat.

During the Blessing of the Throats ceremony, two unlit candles are held next to each person's throat as the priest or deacon says "Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

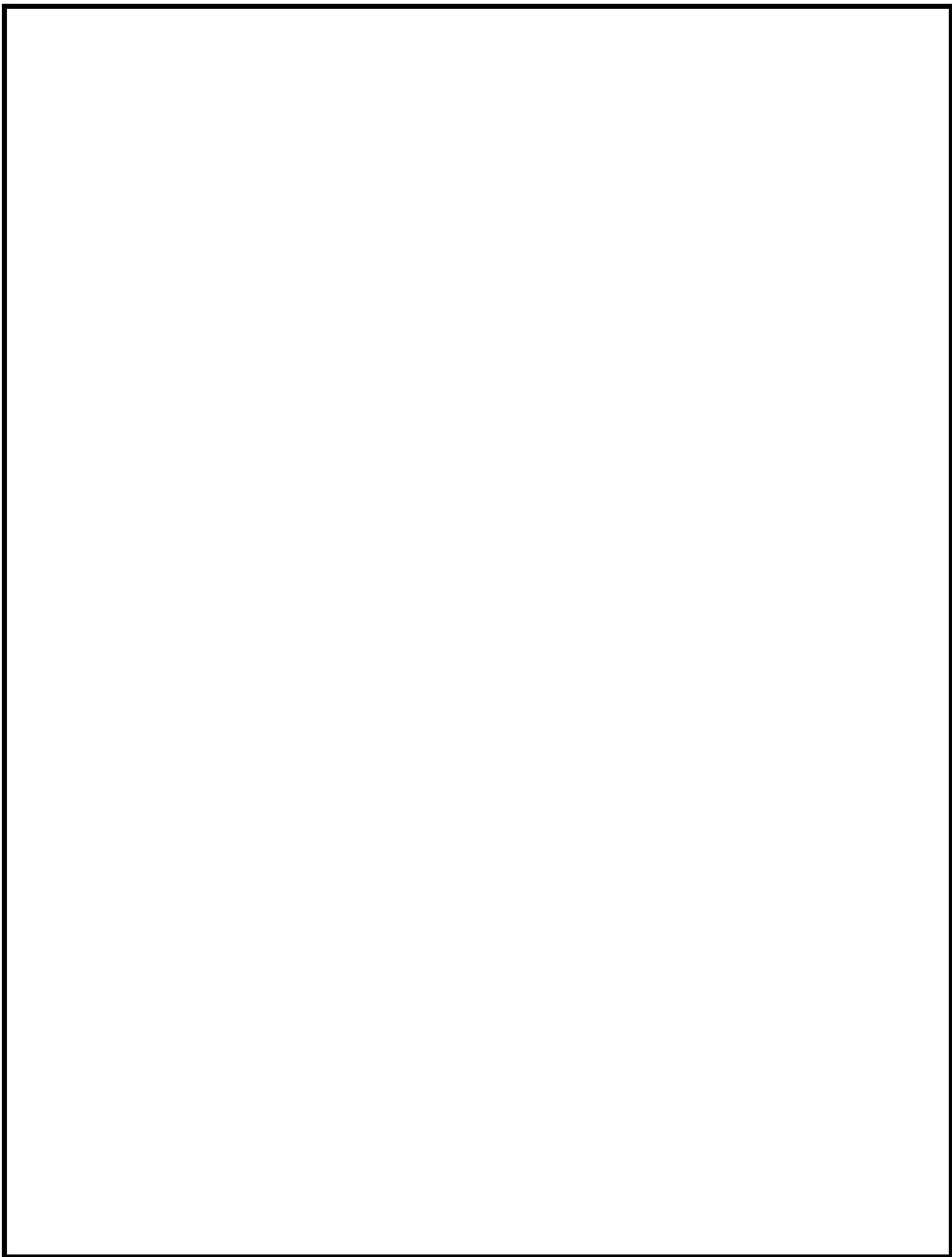
