****FYI – Security cameras** have been installed throughout the church campus. There have been many illegal activities on the grounds. There has also been arrests made related to drug activity. Police have been monitoring the grounds for several months. This is not something new. There has been illegal activity going on for years. Since the cameras have been installed, we have witnessed drug activity while children are on the playground, activity in the cemetery at all hours of the night and people on the grounds with guns. About 3 years ago, someone broke into the school building the night before our picnic and was caught, along with their dog, sleeping in one of the rooms. The police were notified, and this person was arrested. We have had kids in the church with their bikes, and another group of kids trying to get into the front doors of the church after hours. Many times, when staff arrives to work in the morning, cars are parked behind the school building and by the Parish Hall/ Pavilion area with people asleep in their cars. Someone must go wake them up and check on them. This staff member has been told by the police that this could be an extremely dangerous situation. Also, many types of drug paraphernalia have been found on the grounds, as well as other inappropriate items that should never be on our sacred grounds. Therefore, necessary measures needed to be taken to monitor our grounds and keep our church members, staff, and our children safe.
