OFFICE CLOSURES

Our Financial Stability program helps families and individuals prevent homelessness and achieve financial security through case management, education and emergency financial assistance. All Financial Stability clients are receiving the same level of support through virtual portals and via phone. Financial education services are being continued via virtual platforms. Gabriel Project Life Center. Our Gabriel Project Life Center program provides life-affirming services including education, mentoring and material assistance for families to ensure their children have a healthy start to life. All Gabriel Project Life Center clients will continue to receive material assistance and mentoring. All classes will continue to be held on virtual platforms rather than in-person. Multilingual services available.



Immigration Legal Services. Our Immigration Legal Services program offers affordable immigration legal assistance from experienced attorneys and staff, with a focus on family reunification. All Immigration Legal Services clients continue to receive the same level of legal support via our secure virtual portal and phone conference. Multilingual services available.



St. Michael's Veteran Services. Our St. Michael's Veteran Services program provides case management, financial assistance, and referrals to veterans and their dependents regardless of military discharge status. All veteran and client families will receive the same level of support via phone conference. Multilingual services available.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Catholic Charities has increased our community-wide service offerings to respond to challenges posed by the COVID-19 crisis. We continue to increase these additional services as the situation progresses. Currently, Catholic Charities of Central Texas is offering:

- **Free Crisis Counseling.** Catholic Charities Counseling services is offering two free teletherapy counseling sessions for those persons experiencing anxiety or job loss due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- **CCCTX Diaper & Hygiene Drive-Thru.** Catholic Charities is hosting regular no-contact drive-thru events to distribute diapers and personal hygiene kits to families in need. These events are being offered at both our Austin and Brazos Valley office locations. Anyone across Central Texas is welcome. You do not have to be an existing client to participate in these events.
