What happens if some one wronged you and did not ask for forgiveness?</p> <p>It is not easy to be patient and forgive others.</p> <p>Talk with your family about any situations that may be upsetting you. Ask them to work with you to resolve it. Ask if others have issues they need to resolve. Perhaps they are in need of healing also.</p>	<p>Consider going to Confession with your family, attending a daily Mass this week, or participating in Adoration.</p>	<p>With your family, read about the Corporal Work of Mercy #6: "Give alms to the poor."</p> <p>Look through the bible to see where this Work of Mercy was practiced.</p> <p>Use Google as your friend for this!</p>	<p>How often do we see people out on the streets asking for help, money, or food? How many people that we do not see are in need?</p> <p>Have a conversation about giving those in need. Consider how current event might have exacerbated these needs.</p>	<p>Research different organizations that help people in need.</p> <p>Reach out to two or three and find out how you can help their work.</p> <p>Are you aware of anyone who needs money to buy groceries, gas for their car, or help with a bill? What can you do to assist?</p>
