Fr. Francisco's Weekly Reflection

Jesus begins today's Gospel stating, "Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets; I have come not to abolish but to fulfill" (Mt. 5:17). This is important to us as we can understand that Catholicism is the fulfillment of the Jewish covenant. God has come personally to lead us to salvation. The covenants were broken by Israel, who were to build the city on the hill that would draw nations to the one true God. They failed, and Jesus comes to fulfill all the promises made in the Old Testament. Our God is an incredibly God, who offers His son, in sacrifice, as bridge to heaven.
