Assisting Local Flood Relief *From St. George Altar Society:*

As you all are well aware of, the 2019 North Bend Historic Flood Disaster has left many homeless. Those who have a mortgage do have flood insurance but many who own their homes are not required to carry it. For many elderly, this was a way to shave off expenses to their budgets.

With that being said, many have lost everything, with limited funding to replace it.

There are 3 funds at the Platte Valley Bank to donate towards for this flood. The first, titled **“2019 North Bend Historic Flood Disaster Fund”**, is the fund for the people. The other two funds are for the “City of North Bend” and for “North Bend Volunteer Fire Dept”.

The officers of our Altar Society would like to help the people’s fund. The following is the information to give you a better understanding of how the funding would be applied:

1. This committee will be meeting very soon to start deciding how & how much will be dispersed to the people requesting funding.
2. At the moment, there is a form at the Platte Valley Bank that anyone residing in a 68648 OR 68649 zip code may complete. This form will then be returned to the bank or sent to a committee member of the fund.
3. Committee member information: Sandy & Christina Vosler started the fund & moved it to the Platte Valley Bank to make it easier for people to donate towards. The other committee members on this fund are Rev. Michael & Christie Hill (North Bend Presbyterian Church) and Melissa Powell from Ames who works with the Blessings Food Pantry in North Bend.
4. Katey Bode from Platte Valley Bank is the bookkeeper/recorder for this committee. This fund will be “tax free” as long as there are NO EXPENSES, which means no one will be paid for the services, no monies will be used for bookkeeping supplies, nothing spent.... ALL donations will be dispersed to the ones in need.
5. Once forms are submitted, committee members will begin to discuss if criteria has been met & will then determine which recipients are in the greatest need.

Altar Society Action: There has been a motion that the St. George Altar Society could donate \$500 towards this fund. Since the Altar Society money is being spent, the email serves as a meeting and input is requested from the members.

Archdiocese of Omaha have a special collection at this weekend’s Masses to help offset the damage arising from severe flooding in northeast Nebraska. Deacon Tim McNeil, spokesman for the archdiocese, said pastors were asked to conduct a needs assessment in their communities. Based on that evaluation, pastors can request funds from the archdiocese to aid in short- and long-term rebuilding and recovery efforts. “Grants may be distributed to purchase water, food, shelter, cleaning supplies, tools, building materials, and tuition assistance for displaced employees,” McNeil said. McNeil said archdiocesan funds will not be restricted to parishes and their immediate needs. He said pastors can request funds to help with communitywide recovery programs. See Fr.
