1. **Opening Prayer** – Bob Slama
2. **Discernment for incoming council members** – Barb Foley & Father Chuck
  - a. The current and incoming members voted **Dick Roseland** for Vice Chair
  - b. It was decided that the other members will be in charge of the following:

    - ii. Athletics: **Judy Peckham**
    - iii. Christian Formation: **Karen Karr**
    - iv. Evangelization: **Steve Rothermel**
  - c. **Luke Kotcher** will be our new youth representative
  - d. **May 20<sup>th</sup> at 11 AM** is the installation mass for the new members
3. **Budget Review for year starting July 1** – Claude Leezy
  - a. We reviewed the budgeted revenue and expenses for the 2018-2019 fiscal year
4. **Athletics Listening Session** – Bob Slama & Father Chuck
  - a. Sunday, April 15<sup>th</sup> – 12 attended the meeting (6 council members)
  - b. The sense from the meeting was that there is a lack of communication about the situation at hand and the need for leaders in our athletic department
  - c. Our communication software needs to be looked at – it doesn't always work properly so not everyone knew there was a meeting in April
  - d. We had someone volunteer to be the volleyball lay director at the meeting
  - e. May 20<sup>th</sup> – Father is hosting another listening session in the parish hall – we will advertise more to get more people to attend
5. **Revised Rental Agreements** – Father Chuck
  - a. The council looked at the revised rental agreements for the Parish Hall and the Reilly Center
6. **Stewardship Reporting** – Father Chuck
  - a. Annual Catholic Appeal begins this weekend
  - b. Our parish does such wonderful things and the parish community doesn't always know about it. Father is going to make sure we are more aware of all the awesome groups supporting our parish. For example:

7. **Upcoming major projects**
  - a. We will be getting a new sound system for the Parish Hall (July 1<sup>st</sup>)
  - b. We will have new floors in the classrooms and hallway
  - c. We are looking into new room dividers for the classrooms

  - i. Commissions should think about what they have in storage here – anything that isn't being used will be recycled or thrown away

  - c. For the next meeting the council will think about which commission would take it on and think about who could do the photographs for us – maybe the youth could take on uploading the pictures for us?
  - d. Our goal is to have it complete by September
