Quinn was ordained in the Archdiocese of New York, by Cardinal Spellman, June 2, 1962 in St. Patrick's Cathedral, New York City. Since his ordination Father Quinn has ministered as a Catholic High School teacher, a Newman College Chaplain, a resident pastor, and for twenty years as an active duty U.S. Air Force Chaplain. He was assigned to bases in Latin America, Africa, Europe and the United States.

Since 1997, Father Quinn has actively represented the world's poor in over 500 Catholic parishes in the United States. His priestly ministry by word and deed has focused on the needs of the disadvantaged, locally, nationally, and internationally.

Father Quinn is ever aware that to whom much has been given, much will be demanded. "Here I am Lord; I come to do your will". Welcome Father Quinn!
