Dear Parish Family,

This week the Church gives us two special opportunities to pray. First is All Saints Day; a day when the Church celebrates and rejoices in the reality of Heaven, and the knowledge of multitudes praising God, forever with the angels and saints! It is a feast meant to encourage us to follow those faithful men and women who now and forever remain in friendship with God. It is a Holy Day of Obligation. If "obligation" puts you off, then think of it as a Holy Day of "Opportunity".

The second is All Souls Day, November 2nd. While on All Saints Day, we honor all those who are saints, on All Souls Day we recall those who have died, and commend them again to the mercy of God. While we may die in God's friendship, our Souls can still be attached to the things of this world. God, in his mercy, allows this state of purification so that after our souls are healed they can fully enter into the presence of God. This is why we pray for those who have died, this is why we offer Masses for them, pray for them, and recall them. It is normal, healthy, and important to grieve well. Grief is the reality and proof of love! Grief comes and goes; but, in short, we don't "get over it" or "move on", but we do adjust. The death of a loved one does not end the relationship; but it does change it.
