Thank you for your continued generosity. Last week you gave \$5,881. Of that, \$2,806 was given in the pews (including envelopes) and \$3,075 was given online via VanCo. In order to cover our annual budget of \$270,000 we needed to collect at least \$5,000. If this level of giving continues, we should be able to meet our goal of moving the mortgage payments on the hall into the annual budget!
