Letter from the Pastor

We are in the process of preparing to vaccinate 300 people in our neighborhood. We thank the health department for their concern for the people of Main South.

We thank them for recognizing that St. Peter's in our neighborhood is seen by people as a safe and caring place.

We had several meetings discussing the capital campaign Legacy of Hope. They have been very informative. They explained Partners in Charity and the need we have to help one another into the future.

Our retired priests and catholic schools are the big ticket items. Its obvious that some help is needed to care for our retired priests and to make our schools affordable and available to all.

In the reading in the scripture this week we see the Church as a universal and local reality. Barnabas is relating people to one another.

It seems to me that the effort is a good one for us to recognize that we are a local parish which is part of the universal Church.

We have blessings in abundance. As Barnabas we expand our comfort zone and find an expanded relationship with others.

St. John tells us to love not in words and speech but in deed and truth. This gives us confidence and, as the Church, and a mission desperately needed.

Pope Emeritus Benedict writes The Church must always become anew what she already is; she must open the borders between people and break down the barriers between class and race. In her, there cannot be those who are forgotten or looked down upon. The wind and fire of the Holy Spirit must continually break down those barriers that we men and women continue to build between us; we must continually pass from Babel—being closed in on ourselves—to Pentecost.

It all has to commence and continue in our relationship with God. Jesus tells us that He is the vine and we are the branches. If we remain in Him we will bear much fruit—without Him we can do nothing.

Powerful thoughts and so accurate. You think that living without God is the origin of our problems? We are trying to live without God and indeed nothing is happening.

The more we reside in God and God in us the more we act like Him and that, my friends, will change the world.

If you feel marginalized its time to speak out. Believe in the name of Jesus and move about freely. Let's be built up and walk in the Lord with the consolation of the Holy Spirit.
