Saint John Paul II established this particular Church on 21 March 1995. Later that year, Bishop Walsh was installed as the first Bishop of the new Diocese of Las Vegas on 28 June 1995, the Vigil of the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, our Diocesan copatrons.
