diocese is mandatory. Fr. Joseph and Fr. Ron will
be attending the Priests Retreat which begins
Monday afternoon, Jan. 18th and ends on Friday
morning Jan. 22nd. Fr. Joseph and Fr. Ron will be
away from the parish the entire week from Monday
afternoon until Friday afternoon.

Bishop's Faith Appeal – Soon we will
begin the Faith Appeal for this new year.
With so many parishioners still not
attending Mass, this might be a very
difficult year in making our goals. If you
could give a little more than you gave last
year, that will be a tremendous help to us.
Commitment weekend is Feb. 6th and 7th.
Our goals are as follows:

St. Michael's: \$23,723.00...This is a
decrease of \$2858.00 from last year.

St. Raymond's: \$12,491.00...This is an
increase of \$453.00 from last year.

Our Lady of LaSalette: \$10,994.00...This
is a decrease of \$2333.00 from last year.

The Bishop's Faith Appeal is 13% of the
entire parish collection from last year.
Therefore, if there is an increase, it means
that the offertory collection increased over
the previous year. If there is a decrease, it
means that the offertory collection
decreased the previous year.

Christmas decorations need to be taken
down after Mass today at Our Lady of
LaSalette, on Friday January 15th Mass at

New Tax Incentive – the CARES ACT
allows all taxpayers to take a charitable
deduction of up to \$300 in 2020 even if you
do not itemize. Plainly, if you donate in
2020, up to \$300 in cash to a qualified
organization like St. Michael's, your adjusted
gross income will be reduced by up to \$300
and you can still claim the standard
deduction.
