Confirmation is scheduled for Wednesday, May 26, 2021.

Check List:

- ❖ **Attendance at all Zoom classes** is anticipated. If a class is missed, it is expected the student will review and complete the missed lesson using their text book and online videos.
- ❖ Pick-up for your sponsor A Sponsor's Guide, a booklet that includes an overview of the sponsor's role, answers to the top ten Catholic questions and resources, by **January 15, 2021. Give this to your sponsor as soon as possible.** You can pick-up the Guide from the rectory porch 24/7. (The Guides are in a box. You will find your name on a bag containing the Guide for your sponsor.)
- ❖ *The Confirmation Sponsor's Information* sheet is due by **February 1, 2021 (download)**
- ❖ If you were **not** Baptized at St. Jude Church, a copy of your Baptism Certificate **is required and due by February 1, 2021.**
- ❖ If you are not a member of St. Jude Parish, complete the *Practicing My Faith* form and submit it by **February 1, 2021. (download)**
- ❖ The *Choosing a Confirmation Name* assignment is due **March 1, 2021. (download)**
- ❖ **Submit a letter to Father Adrian Milik**
The letter should demonstrate your understanding of Confirmation by responding to the following:
 1. What does receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation mean to you?
 2. Do you feel ready to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation? What makes you feel that way?
 3. Choose two gifts of the Holy Spirit and describe how they will assist you in continuing your Faith development.Your letter is due by **APRIL 12, 2021.** You can either email using amilik@saintjudewaltham.org or drop off your letter at the rectory for Father Adrian.
- ❖ **Confession/Reconciliation** - It is recommended that before you **receive the sacrament of Confirmation you receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.** Confessions are heard at Saint Jude Parish on Saturdays at 2:30-3:30 pm or choose another option at a local parish.
- ❖ Complete 10 hours of service to your family or in your neighborhood (staying within safety guidelines). *Service Summary is due by May 1, 2021 (download)*
