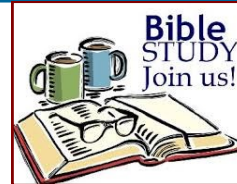
Join us for the Augustine Institute's Bible Study on

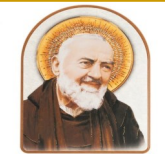

### Confirmation Preparation

Our Lady of the Rosary's Confirmation Program will provide sacramental preparation for juniors in high school who wish to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. This sacramental preparation is required for all juniors, regardless of whether they attend Catholic school, public school, private school, or home school.

**Note:** For any juniors who do not attend Catholic schools, enrollment in our Parish School of Religion is also required.

Confirmation preparation seminars will be held on **Sunday afternoons 4:00pm-5:45pm** in Vincent Hall, on the following Sundays: **September 29, November 3, November 24, December 15, January 26, and February 16.**

March 7 and 8 will be a Confirmation retreat with St. Pius X at Camp Abbey near Covington. There will be a group service project on Saturday, March 28, in the morning and early afternoon.

**The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated on Saturday, May 16, at 4pm Mass by Archbishop Alfred Hughes (Retired Archbishop of New Orleans).**

### Interested in Becoming Catholic?

The Catholic Church is always happy to welcome new members into her arms. Our parish stands ready to assist and guide those who would like to become Catholic. If you are a member of another Christian denomination or if you have never been baptized, **we invite you to consider the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA).** RCIA is the process by which someone who is not yet Catholic can enter into the Church. It is a time of prayer and study, an opportunity to grow in a relationship with God and with the larger parish community. Participating in RCIA does not mean that you are making a firm commitment; it simply means that you are interested in learning more about our faith. For those who are already Catholic, perhaps this could be an opportunity for you to invite a family member or friend to consider becoming Catholic.
