The biblical image of us as the flock of sheep is not a particularly flattering one. Sheep without a shepherd are truly sad, because they most likely will perish either from their inability to fend for themselves or from their lack of defenses against predators. Placing ourselves in the heart of this unflattering image can reinforce our faith. Until we come to a profound realization of how much we need a shepherd, we cannot appreciate how deeply blessed we are to have been given a Shepherd, one who laid down his life for us and was raised to life eternal in the Spirit, so he might guide us and we might follow him in faith forever.

**PARISH LITURGY SCHEDULE  
 Effective May 1, 2020**

**At this time, no more than 10 people will be permitted to attend each Mass.** (The week will begin on Friday and end the following Thursday.) Those who wish to attend a Mass must sign up for a particular Mass by visiting the parish website (<https://olr-nola.org/public-masses>) or by calling the parish office: (504-488-2659).

**Parishioners will not be permitted to sign up for more than one Mass per week in order to allow as many different people as possible to attend.**

There will be a parishioner present at each Mass to make sure that the 10-person rule is observed.

*Please keep in mind that the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays is still dispensed - no one is required to attend Sunday Mass. Also, we still strongly encourage anyone who is particularly vulnerable to Coronavirus to avoid coming to church.*

When you arrive for Mass, the only door to church that will be open will be the one at the wheelchair ramp. There will be a volunteer present to make sure that only those who have signed up for Mass will enter the church.
