FROM OUR PASTOR, FR. ANTONY

My Dearest Parishioners in Jesus Christ,

What motivated the two persons — Jairus and the woman suffering from haemorrhage — to go to Jesus in their utter desperation? It was their firm faith in the power of Jesus. The Gospel tells us that, as a ruler of the Synagogue, Jairus was one of the most important and respected men in the society. The person of Jairus reveals two things worthy of reflection, among others.

First he was a man with an open mind and spirit. When all possible roads had been closed, he was ready to experiment with something new. He knew that even though nobody was able to help, perhaps this leader, Jesus, reputed to be a healer, could help. We should never lose sight of the many obstacles which stood in the way of Jairus' coming and kneeling to make his bold prayer.

What a contrast Jesus provides to the normal human attitudes. Many come to Jesus with an inflated ego, with prestige, learning and position, with a "what-can-this-fellow-do-for-us?" attitude. Jairus today reminds us to keep our mind open, see and venture. Let Jesus bring health and wholeness into life.

Second, Jairus besought Jesus, saying, "My little daughter is at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her so that she may be made well and live". What a tremendous affirmation of faith! It was a clear indication of a father's love for his child and of his sense of need. But those words carry the eternal truth that whatever Jesus lays His hands upon, **LIVES**. History bears ample proof to this amazing fact: Jesus laid His hands on Saul, the fierce persecutor, and he was transformed into the most zealous apostle, Paul. He laid His hands on an evil, accursed thing, a cross; and it lived. There are many other occasions when Jesus laid His hands and brought people back to life.

Today how many millions are spiritually sick and dying, who have not the faith, humility and confidence of Jairus to cast themselves at the feet of Jesus and ask Him to cure them? If only they would, like the suffering woman, push their way toward Christ through the throng of worldly pride, worldly interests and worldly pleasures and say to Him, "Come, Lord, and lay Your hands upon me so that I may be made well and live".

CELEBRATION AND PILGRIMAGE

Bishop Fabbro and Bishop Dabrowski invite the faithful to celebrate the SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY at the Diocesan Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary in Merlin on **Wednesday, August 15, 2018**. Bishop Fabbro will celebrate Mass at 11 o'clock, followed by lunch. Prior to the Mass, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be offered. After lunch, a Rosary Procession will take place, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 2:15 p.m.

The faithful can also join a walking pilgrimage to the Shrine. There will be two starting points for the pilgrimage; a 10 KM walk will depart from the North Buxton Museum at 8:00 a.m., and a 5 KM walk will depart from the Merlin Community Hall at 9:00am. Pilgrims arriving by car will be able to park their vehicles at these locations, and volunteers will be available after the day's celebrations to drive pilgrims back to the parking lots. A diocesan representative will be at each of the two departure locations and will lead pilgrims to the Shrine. Pilgrims are welcome to bring their own lunches, or purchase a hamburger or hotdog from the Knights of Columbus for a small fee. It is not necessary to register for this celebration.
