### FROM OUR PASTOR, FR. ANTONY

My Dearest Parishioners

Greetings to you my dear Sisters and Brothers. As the weather grows colder and the leaves fall and Christmas approaches, it is natural that our thoughts turn to those whom we have loved, and who are no longer with us. How appropriate, that the Catholic Church offers us November, which begins with All Saints Day and All Souls Day, as the month of the Holy Souls in Purgatory—those who have died in grace, yet who failed in this life to make satisfaction for all their sins.

In recent years, perhaps no Catholic Doctrine has been more misunderstood by Catholics themselves than the Doctrine of Purgatory. Consequently, we tend to downplay it, even seem a little embarrassed by it, and it is the Holy Souls who suffer because of our discomfort with the Doctrine.

Purgatory is not, as many people think, one last trial; all of those who make it to Purgatory will one day be in Heaven. Purgatory is where those who have died in grace, but who have not fully atoned for the temporal punishments resulting from their sins, go to finish their atonement before entering Heaven. A soul in Purgatory may suffer, but she/he has the assurance that they will ultimately enter Heaven when their punishment is complete. Catholics believe Purgatory is an expression of God's love, His desire to cleanse our souls of all that might keep us from experiencing the fullness of joy in Heaven.

As Christians, we don't travel through this world alone. Our salvation is wrapped up with the salvation of others, and charity requires us to come to their aid. The same is true of the Holy Souls. In their time in Purgatory, they can pray for us, and we should pray for the faithful departed that they may be freed from the punishment for their sins and enter into Heaven.

We should pray for the dead throughout the year, especially on the anniversary of their death, but in this month of the Holy Souls, we should devote some time every day to prayer for the dead. We should start with those closest to us—our father and mother, for instance—but we should also offer prayers for all the souls, and especially for those most forsaken.

In solidarity with the Universal Church, our Parish Family honours the deceased on three different occasions this month. We had a special Mass on Friday, November 2, to commemorate the deceased brothers and sisters from our family. November 4 and 11 are Cemetery Sundays in our Parish. Those two Sundays, soon after the 11.00 a.m. Mass, I will be available at the Cemetery to pray with you at the graveside of your deceased loved ones. Candlelight Prayer Service is another major event in our community to specially pray for the deceased. **This year, the Candlelight Prayer Service is scheduled on Tuesday, November 13, at 7:00 pm.** During this service, though we call out the names of only those who left us over the year, this event is also held to remember and pray for all the deceased from our family over the years. Hence, I request you, all my Brothers and Sisters, to kindly be present at this service and show our mutual concern and sympathy over the loss of our loved ones.
