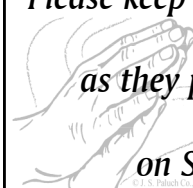

FROM SUE HOFGARTNER, PASTORAL MINISTER

Dear Parishioners,
During the month of November we are invited with the universal Church to remember our deceased brothers and sisters. I believe it is also an opportunity to reflect on the meaning of the *Communion of Saints*. Besides our Church family on earth, we belong to a larger family of God, called the *Communion of Saints*. It is our Catholic belief that our soul is immortal and does not perish when it separates from our body at death. At the final resurrection, it will be reunited with our body. The *Communion of Saints* is made up of all men and women who have placed their hope in Christ and belong to him through Baptism, whether they have already died or are still alive. In Christ, we are one Body and we live in a communion that encompasses heaven and earth. Communion and community are two words with one root and one reality. It is people who love and support one another. The *Communion of Saints* includes three groups, sometimes referred to as the three states of the Church.

The Church Militant – the Church on earth, or the Church in pilgrimage.

The Church Suffering – the Church in purgatory. Those who die in the state of grace and friendship with God but who are not fully purified are assured of their eternal salvation. They must undergo a purification to attain the holiness needed to enter heaven. This process is called Purgatory. We pray for those in purgatory that they may soon be with God in heaven.

The Church Triumphant – the Church in heaven, or perfection. Honour of the Saints includes imitation of them, prayers addressed to them, reverence given to their relics, and the right use of images.

During the month of November, as we await our fulfillment of Christ's promise, may we honour our deceased relatives and friends as we remember all those who have died and have gone before us marked with the sign of faith.
