Dear Parishioners,

The school year will be coming to a close soon, the season of summer is quickly approaching, and vacations will soon abound. Many of us spend more time outdoors throughout the summer months and during our holiday time. I thought this would be a good opportunity to reflect on the beauty of creation.

Have you ever found yourself overwhelmed by the beauty of nature or creation? For many people, union with God or the awareness of the presence of God is experienced in nature. It is humbling to realize and acknowledge that the same God who created all the beauty we see and so much more, also created each one of us. God's loving presence is evident in the beauty and in the balance of all creation. God has been revealing His love, goodness and beauty since the very beginning through the natural world of His creation.
