

Join us every Wednesday before Mass at 8:00am to pray the Rosary for the sick of the parish and on Fridays at 8:00am for Peace.





## Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Mary's of the Lake:

As we begin our Month of October, the month dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary, I'd like to renew with you a few details I learned concerning a favorite devotion of Pope Francis on 'Our Lady Undoer of Knots.' These details are mainly from an OUR SUNDAY VISITORS' pamphlet issued in 2014.



As you know, devotions to Mary have entered the Church in various ways: Apparitions (Fátima & Lourdes), sacramentals (rosary), doctrines (Immaculate Conception), and miraculous icons or statues. At

times, a devotion arises simply because it touches minds & hearts of those in particular needs. Devotion to MARY UNDOERS OF KNOTS touches those who may be tangled by 'knots.' They turned to Mary for intercession that those 'knots' may be untangled. The devotion to 'Our Lady Undoer of Knots' has been around for just over 30 years ago. Pope Francis is credited as bringing it to his home country Argentina. From there it spread to Brazil and now even to the entire Catholic world. "While this devotion is new, the image of Mary Undoer of Knots and its story are not. It began in 1612 with a miserably unhappy marriage. A German nobleman, Wolfgang Langenmante, and his wife, Sophie, were on the brink of divorce. Desperate, Wolfgang sought advice from Fr. Jakob Rem, a Jesuit priest. The story goes that at their last visit, Wolfgang handed his wedding ribbon to Fr. Jakob, who lifted it up to an image of 'Our Lady of the Snows' and, while untying its knots, prayed: 'I raise up the bond of marriage, that all knots be loosed and resolved.' (At the time, a bride and groom were 'tied' together in the wedding ceremony with a ribbon, symbolizing their unbreakable union.). The unknotted ribbon became bright white—a sign of Mary's intercession—and the Langenmantel's marriage survived... Pope Francis' introduction to the devotion came while he was in Germany in 1986, studying for his doctorate. While visiting the Church of St. Peter am Perlach in Augsburg, then Father Jorge saw a painting of our Lady untying the knots in a white ribbon. He was captivated by the painting and the story behind it. He bought a postcard of the image. As cardinal, he had the image engraved into a chalice and presented it to Pope Benedict XVI."

◆ Do you have 'knots' in life that seem impossible to untangle: Marriage troubles, problems concerning money, employment, worries, illness, loneliness or desperation...? With love and devotion, let us come to Mary, and ask her to pray for us now and even at the hour of our death.

"O Mary, Mother to whom God entrusted the undoing of the knots in the lives of His children. I entrust into your hands the ribbons of my life. No one, not even the Evil One himself, can take it away from your precious care. In your hands there is no knot that cannot be undone. Powerful Mother, by the grace and intercessory power with your Son and my Liberator, Jesus, take into your hands today this knot (*mention your need*). I beg you to untie it for the glory of God, once for all, for you are my hope."
