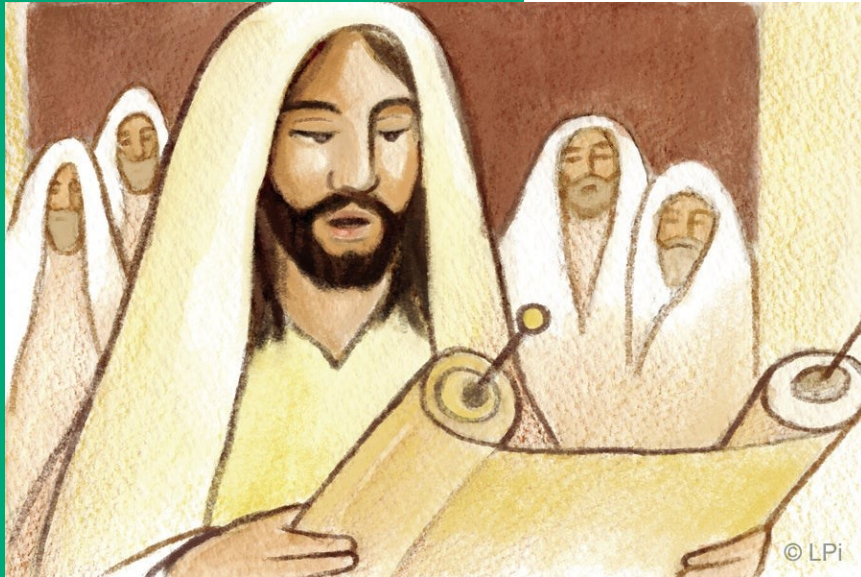

Foundation for Children in Need is a Catholic lay organization based in Arlington Heights, IL. Dr. Geetha Yeruva, Co-Founder of FCN is very happy to visit us and share about their mission work in the interior villages of India. FCN sponsors 2000 children and college students. They have been responsible for building several schools, boarding homes, a community health center and two homes for the elderly. 1500 children born with Cleft Lip and Cleft Palate are helped with free corrective surgeries in the past 7 years. ## Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Mary's of the Lake:



♦REVIEW: We are now in the middle of the 'Year of St. Joseph' proclaimed by Pope Francis for the universal Church. As you may remember: In our Green Bay Diocese we celebrated the *Year of St. Joseph* proclaimed by Bishop Ricken from March 19, 2020 to March 19, 2021. [The goal of the Year was to ask the intercession of St. Joseph in 3 specific ways: For the strength & healing of marriages and family life; For the Universal

Church –especially all church leaders & For a significant increase in vocations to the priesthood in our Green Bay Diocese]. Reflecting on these 2 events, Bishop wrote in March 2021: "In the Diocese of Green Bay, we are in the midst of completing a local year dedicated to St. Joseph. Little did we know that when this year began on March 19, 2020, we would find ourselves in a year filled with disease and much fear. Happily, the quiet prayers of St. Joseph have helped our diocese weather the difficulties of the past year and we are now poised to rise and begin again. How pleased I was when we all learned, this past December, that Pope Francis had declared this current year, from Dec. 8, 2020, to Dec. 8, 2021, the universal 'Year of Saint Joseph'! What we had started here in the Diocese of Green Bay last March, we now have additional time to participate in."

♦In his apostolic letter 'Patris Corde' ('With a Father's Heart'), Pope Francis proclaimed a *Year of St. Joseph* as an invitation to celebrate the 150th anniversary of St. Joseph being declared as Patron of the Universal Church, so that 'each of us can discover in Joseph – the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence – an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble'. According to our Holy Father, 'The aim of this Apostolic Letter is to increase our love for this great saint, to encourage us to implore his intercession and to imitate his virtues and his zeal.' At the end of the Apostolic Letter Pope Francis shares a prayer to St. Joseph as follows:

Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. To you God entrusted his only Son; in you Mary placed her trust; with you Christ became man. Blessed Joseph, to us too, show yourself a father and guide us in the path of life. Obtain for us grace, mercy, and courage, and defend us from every evil. Amen.

✦ May I invite you to say this prayer by yourself or with your family on some regular basis (maybe once a week). May each of us 'discover in Joseph – the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence – an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble!'

### MinisTree Program

July 1st we can start again! Through Catholic United Financial the Minis TREE program is designed to identify and meet some of the volunteer needs in our parish. By participating in this program, you are helping to meet our parish needs while also supporting our religious education program. For every 25 "leaves" that are completed or turned in, Catholic United Financial will contribute \$125, up to a maximum of \$500 in a calendar year. Leaves" can be filled out for some of the following activities: cleaning the sacristy, watering flowers, bringing in food pantry items, sewing supplies, food for a funeral or helping at a funeral meal. Any Parish activities you volunteer at can be reported. Some of the cards are already printed with an activity such as "food pantry donation" or "cleaning" printed on them. Other cards are blank and things like "worked at funeral" or "food for funeral", etc. can be written on them. "Leaves" (activity cards) will be available on the bulletin board in the back corner of the church. When you have completed an activity fill out one of the cards and put it in the manilla envelope marked Completed MinisTree Cards.
