

◆ As we all have known and experienced that the terrible *Covid-19 pandemic* has forced our parish as well as others in our Diocese and in our Country to pause many or most parish activities for over a year. As far as liturgies, during the first

few months of 'Lock Down' and 'Safer at Home' we could not celebrate Mass in public. Then came the time of 'Communion Outside of Mass,' and then 'Return to Mass with up to 25% Occupancy,' and finally Mass without strict limitation of number of participants. Now, even with the danger of the Delta Variant & the Diocese continues to offer sanitary guidelines to deal with the pandemic, parish leaders are being encouraged to find ways to **WELCOME or WELCOME BACK people to Church**. During the height of the pandemic, a few people seriously asked me if people would go back to church when Covid is gone!
