Living Kidney donors:

- \*Must be healthy people who volunteer to donate go through medical evaluation, including education about risks/benefits
- \*Can change their minds any time, no questions asked
- \*Are generally back to normal activities 4-6 weeks after surgery
- \*Are covered by the receivers insurance for all costs related to the donation
- \*Do not have to be the same blood type

☆ A REMINDER: Pope Francis proclaimed a YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH for the universal church to be from Dec. 8, 2020 to Dec. 8, 2021. This special Year is an invitation to celebrate the 150th anniversary of St. Joseph being declared as Patron of the Universal Church, so that 'each of us can discover in Joseph – the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence – an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble.' During the last few months of this gracious year, please turn to this great Saint to ask him to intercede for us – especially that God may deliver us and the whole world from the terrible Covid-19 and its variants.



◆ Also: As you know we are now in the month of October! Besides being the MONTH OF ROSARY, October is also the month reminding us TO RESPECT FOR LIFE. We are called to consider more deeply why every human life is valuable and reflect on how to build a culture that protects life from conception to natural death. Very importantly, during October this year the Church in the United States also highlights **St. Joseph in his serene way of respecting life** – especially the life of the Blessed Mary and of the Baby Jesus. **The 2021 Respect Life Poster** (above) features four special scenes from the life of St. Joseph, which highlight his Respect for Life, and includes the petition, 'ST. Will you take some time to look at the picture in some silent reflection on each of the four scenes to find inspiration from our beloved **St. Joseph, Defender of Life.**

◆ While the angel of the Lord appeared to Mary to announce that she would bring forth the Savior of the world, it was revealed to St. Joseph in a series of dreams how God's plans would be brought to fulfillment. As Pope Francis highlights, 'God trusted Joseph, as did Mary, who found in him someone who would not only save her life, but would always provide for her and her child.'
