Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Mary's of the Lake:

This Sunday we celebrate the SOLEMNITY OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST THE KING OF THE UNIVERSE, which marks an end of a church year; and a beginning of a new liturgical year with the Advent Season.

◆ **The SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE KING** was instituted by



Pope Pius XI in 1925, in response to the growing 'secularism' of the time. The respect for Jesus Christ and His Church was seriously waning. Indeed, Jesus –the Way, the Truth & the Life, as well as

His teachings faced being ignored or taken so lightly! Being instituted in 1925, this Feast of Christ the King is apparently quite recent. However, what the Feast celebrates is as old as our Christian Faith itself. Hundreds of years before Jesus' Birth, Isaiah the prophet wrote: 'For to us a child is born, to us a son is given...He will REIGN on DAVID'S THRONE and over HIS KINGDOM, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever'. (Isaiah. 9: 6-7) Then when God's time came He sent the Archangel Gabriel to the Blessed Virgin Mary with the message: 'Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus. He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give him the THRONE of David His Father, (Luke 1: 32) and he will RULE over the house of Jacob forever, and of HIS KINGDOM there will be no end.' Jesus came to us as a promised king, but Jesus confirmed: 'My KINGDOM does not belong to this world.' (Jn 18: 36)

◆ We now live in a time when authorities are easily suspicious and values (even Christian values) are deemed 'relative.' The Feast of Christ the King invites us to **rededicate our life to Jesus Christ the King** of the Universe, the King of our hearts, and the King of our lives. We are called to uphold all Christian values. We are called to view all the joys as well as all the challenges of life against the absolute background --i.e. **Jesus Christ the King of the Universe**. He always has to be the first priority and not the last resort in our life of faith!

MASS ON THANKSGIVING DAY (Nov 25th) will be at 8:30 am in Lakewood. May I invite you to plan to go to church this day to give thanks to God for all we have received, and to ask His blessings upon us, our families, our country and our world.
