PASTOR'S MESSAGE Church Renovation in this Jubilee Year!

We are excited with the undertaking of a number of projects in this 70th Jubilee year to keep St. Anne's shining into the future. Given the 'wrinkles' a 70 year old building cultivates, a number of areas need refreshing/updating some relating to safety and energy efficiency. The projects are being managed by St. Anne's Building Committee under the auspices and directives of the Hamilton Dioceses Building Committee.



Tiling of the Sanctuary and Sacristy:

We have told Twin City Tile to proceed with the tiling of this area, to replace dated, worn & badly wrinkled carpet posing a tripping hazard. Light colored tile, with dark accents complimentary to existing terrazzo & finishes around the altar, ambo (lectern used for readings), tabernacle and steps will bring a fresh, clean, dramatic change. The tabernacle platform is being reduced in size, the steps under the statues are being removed, and the commentator's reading stand is being moved forward as well. This project was made possible by a \$20000 grant from the Ex Corde Foundation of the Diocese of Hamilton, and a substantial gift from long-time parishioner/committee member Mr. Dennis Edissi, owner of Twin City Tile. Work will begin as soon as Father Ray returns from India, on March 3. We'll be posting blueprints of the changes on our bulletin boards and at the back lobby a poster board with more details.

Electrical/Lighting changes:

Phase 1: We have received 3 quotes and retained Charged Electric to upgrade the lights in the sanctuary and church to LED fixtures. We should see (pun!) significant improvements, short/long term energy savings from this project, part of which is covered by government rebates. LED lights are highly efficient, last much longer than the present incandescent lamps/bulbs so we will no longer have to contend with frequent bulb replacement costs & risks (heights). Lighting at the altar is very poor/problematic/inefficient hence dark. Existing fluorescent lights inside either side of the altar will be replaced by LED track lighting, which is brighter and can be directed better on the altar. Spot lights over the arch are dangerously high to replace bulbs and fixtures are timeworn so they will be abandoned and removed. Replacement of a circuit panel is necessary as parts are no longer available and safety becoming a potential issue.

Phase 2: Further review of electrical, lighting and the fire alarm system is being done for another possible grant from the Ex Corde Foundation of the Diocese of Hamilton in the near future.

Confessional Room:

The room currently used is cramped and poorly laid out. We will be rearranging the privacy barrier to make it easier to maneuver in the room. Carpeting will be removed as Twin City Tile is restoring the original terrazzo flooring. A traditional private confessional is still available inside the back of the church.

Pews and Piano:

With the approval of the diocese, you'll notice we have removed two rows of front pews to make more room for funeral liturgies, school masses, and make space for folk choir and other musical leadership at the front of the church. The baby grand piano in this new space, and the cost of tuning, was donated by a generous parishioner (Meakes Family) and is being refinished in-house. This area will

better accommodate our folk choir and some of the current choir who will now enjoy a more suitable space to lead our celebrations from the front of the church at various times during the 5pm and 9am masses. The choir loft will still be used at the 11 am mass. These pews are currently being stored inhouse.
