All are welcome to come to this celebration.

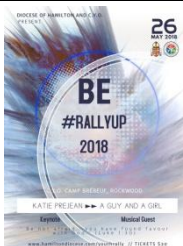
Parish Bible Study: Gospel of Matthew Apr 25 – May 30
