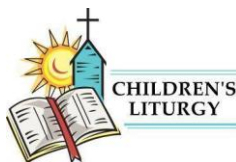

ST. ANNE REFUGEE MINISTRY

The St. Anne's Refugee Ministry is embarking on our second refugee sponsorship. As you recall, St. Anne's parish sponsored the Kaekh family, a Syrian refugee family of six from Jordan. The family arrived in Kitchener in June 2016 and is doing very well adjusting to life in Canada.



St. Anne's has received a donation of \$30,000.00 from some parishioners to help pay for a second refugee sponsorship. An additional \$16,000.00 is needed and fundraising will begin in the parish starting this Thanksgiving weekend. Special donation envelopes are found in the bulletin and at the doors of the church. The fundraising will extend until October 2019 and we hope to have secured all the necessary funds by then.

We are working with Erin Pease, Hamilton Diocese Director of Refugees to submit an application for a sponsorship family.

Please pray for the Refugee Ministry committee members as we take a leap of faith once again to sponsor and provide hope to a refugee family for a future of stability and peace. We ask for your continued generosity and support of this life-giving, humanitarian work. If you would like to be part of the refugee



ministry, please let us know. We can't do this alone. We need your help to make this happen.
