Next Week's Liturgical Readings

Sunday, Feb 24, 2019 – Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

- 1) 1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23
- 2) 1 Corinthians 15:45-49
- 3) Luke 6:27-38

FOCUS: Jesus challenges us to act with love.

Being a Christian – truly following Jesus – isn't easy. Today's Gospel is a reminder of that fact. Jesus describes what it means to act with love. He challenges us to do what seems humanly impossible: to love our enemies and forgive those who hurt us. These are not easy tasks! Only with the help of Jesus can we truly do what he commands.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, David does not allow anyone to harm Saul when they have the opportunity to do so, and makes it clear to Saul's troops what he did. In Corinthians, Paul describes Jesus as the second Adam, the spiritual man. Jesus, in the Gospel, explains to his disciples all that the commandment "to love" entails.

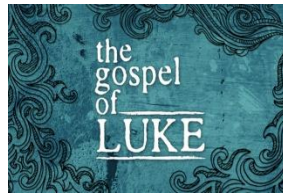
