Next Week's Liturgical Readings

Sunday, June 30, 2019 – Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

- 1) 1 Kings 19:16b, 19-21
- 2) Galatians 5:1, 13-18
- 3) Luke 9:51-62

FOCUS: Jesus summons us to him and then sends us out as messengers to proclaim his kingdom.

The Christian life is one of following the way of Christ. Jesus calls us out of our worldliness, out of our habits and attachments, to follow his way. And after we encounter the Lord, he sends us out to proclaim the truth of his kingdom.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the reading from the First Book of Kings, the Lord tells Elijah to find Elisha and anoint him as *prophet to succeed* [him]. Elisha, though he wants to wait until he can say goodbye to his parents, nevertheless slaughters his oxen and follows. In the second reading, Paul writes to the Galatians about the freedom that Christ came to bring us which, if we live by the Spirit, allows us to not be controlled by the desires of the flesh. In the Gospel, Jesus is making his final journey to Jerusalem, and tells those who want to follow him that they must do so without delay.

Jesus has given us His Body to eat and His Blood to drink so as to nourish us on our journey towards the Kingdom.
