Next Week's Liturgical Readings

Sunday, July 14, 2019 – Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

1) Deuteronomy 30:10-14

2) Colossians 1:15-20

3) Luke 10:25-37

FOCUS: God's commandments are written in our hearts.

Today we are challenged to love God with our entire being and our neighbour as ourselves. On the face of it, these are difficult commandments to live out day after day, but Moses reminds us that they are written in our hearts. Our task is to listen to God's word and carry it out at each moment, in each situation we face.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Moses calls on the people to heed the voice of God written in their hearts. The second reading reminds us of Christ Jesus as the image of the invisible God, through whom all things were created and who made peace by the blood of his cross. In the Gospel, Jesus points to the Good Samaritan, with his unselfish works of mercy, as an example of a good neighbour.
