Next Week's Liturgical Readings

Sunday, November 10, 2019 – Thirty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time

- 1) 2 Maccabees 7:1-2, 9-14
- 2) 2 Thessalonians 2:16-3:5
- 3) Luke 20:27-38 or 20:27, 34-38

FOCUS: The God we worship is the God of the living.

In putting Jesus on the spot, the Sadducees were unexpectedly rewarded with a firm declaration of the truth of the Resurrection. By proclaiming God to be the God of the living, Jesus strengthens the resolve of all who place their trust in him and who hope in a share in the eternal life of God.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

Our first reading from Maccabees recalls the bravery of seven brothers and their mother who preferred death to denying their hope in the God of Israel. Saint Paul reminds the Thessalonians of God's fidelity and encourages them to find hope and strength in the Lord. In the Gospel, the Sadducees attempt to put Jesus on the spot on the topic of resurrection.

The registration date has now passed. If you are not signed up but have a child in grade 2 or above who would like to receive these Sacraments, please contact the office ASAP.



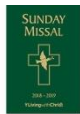
Confirmation

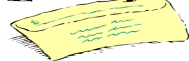
