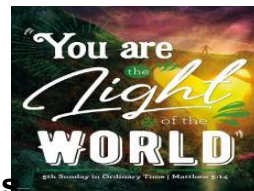

**Next Week's Liturgical Readings**

**February 16, 2020 – Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

- 1) Sirach 15:15-20
- 2) 1 Corinthians 2:6-10
- 3) Matthew 5:17-37

**FOCUS: Jesus came to fulfill the law so that heaven could be opened to the righteous.**

Jesus' teachings are not primarily about the joys and easiness of the Christian life, but rather about the commandments that our loving Father gives to us for our freedom and good. He, who is perfect love, made us in love and sent his Son out of love to teach us what it means to partake in his life – both here and forever.

**LITURGY OF THE WORD**

In the first reading, Sirach tells the people they can choose to follow the commandments, or not. But keeping the commandments will save them. In Saint Paul's Letter to the Corinthians, he writes of the greatness prepared for those who love God. In the Gospel from Matthew, Jesus teaches about the law. He says that he has come to fulfil the law, and that those who keep it will be called the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

The Saint John's Bible was created over thirteen years by an international team of artists, calligraphers, and biblical and theological scholars. This massive work is bound in seven volumes, each measuring just over 90 x 60 centimetres (three by two feet). All together the Bible contains 1,150 pages and 160 illuminations. A stunning Heritage Edition of the Saint John Bible is available in the Hamilton Diocese. Several volumes will be here at St Anne from February 9-16. After Mass on February 9 and 16, all are invited downstairs for a coffee Sunday and to view a volume of the Bible up close.
