Next Week's Liturgical Readings

April 19, 2020 – DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

- 1) Acts 2:42-47
- 2) 1 Peter 1:3-9

FOCUS: We are reconciled to God, in his Divine Mercy, through his Son.

The Church continues to celebrate and give thanks for the mystery of the Resurrection. God has anointed his only Son as our Savior and Redeemer. So with hearts full of hope, joy, and faith, let us be reconciled to God in his Divine Mercy and share that mercy with the world.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

Saint Luke describes the early Christian community, as they devoted themselves to prayer, the communal life....and....the breaking of bread. Peter's Letter stresses the living hope that believers now have through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. In John's Gospel, the resurrected Jesus appears to his disciples, saying, Peace be with you and showing them his wounds. He breathes on them, and says, receive the Holy Spirit and grants them the authority to forgive sins. Later, he convinces Thomas of the truth of the Resurrection.
