**Next Week's Liturgical Readings**

**August 16, 2020 – 20<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

- 1) Isaiah 56:1, 6-7
- 2) Romans 11:13-15, 29-32
- 3) Matthew 15:21-28

**FOCUS: God's grace and mercy are promised to all.**

The readings today wrestle with the questions of who is *in* and who is *out*. When it comes to God's grace, who will receive it? We learn that all who accept the gift of faith are incorporated into the covenant relationship with God.

**LITURGY OF THE WORD**

The Lord speaks through Isaiah, giving his promise that all *who hold to [his] covenant* will be brought to his *holy mountain*. In the second reading, Saint Paul tells the Gentiles that God *delivered all to disobedience, that he might have mercy upon all*. In the Gospel, a Canaanite woman asks Christ to have pity on her, for her *daughter is tormented by a demon*. In spite of initial rejection, the woman perseveres in faith and Jesus heals her daughter.
